



Streetsbrook Infant & Nursery School

The Government is continuing to provide funding of £150 million in 2014/15 to support and enhance the quality of sport in primary schools and in developing healthy lifestyles. (The funding may continue after this but this has not been confirmed by the DfE.).

Allocation

Funding for schools has been calculated on the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11) as at the annual census in January 2013.

Based on a full year, all schools with 17 more primary aged pupils will receive a lump sum of £8,000 plus a premium of £5 per pupil. This will mean Streetsbrook receiving a total of £8900.

For the Academic Year 2013/14 the grant was used in the following ways:

- Specialist teaching
- Professional development opportunities for all staff
- PE leadership time
- Lunchtime activities
- Extra-curricular activities
- Sports competitions and events

Academic Year 2014-15

In September, Streetsbrook received a grant of £3351 for school sports. An additional £5244 is due in March 2015. This money has been allocated in a number of ways to support the on-going development and quality of sports and PE for all children:
