Dear Parents

Re: Year 2 Blackwell Trip 2018

We are delighted to inform you that interest for the Blackwell trip has once again been very popular and almost all of Year 2 children have signed up for this fantastic residential opportunity. Thank you for making your deposit payment of £20.00.

Streetsbrook strives to give every child the opportunity to attend Blackwell and as a result we are only able to accommodate this large number by facilitating two trips. As you will be aware from the previous letter sent to you all in December we have secured 2 separate dates. Therefore the two trips will be taking place as follows:

- **Children in 2F will be going to Blackwell from 14 – 16 May 2018**
- **Children in 2A will be going to Blackwell from 13 – 15 June 2018**

Obviously both of these dates are during term-time and should not therefore cause any significant disruption.

We can now confirm that the total cost for each child attending the residential trip is £172.00, which is only a small increase on last year's cost. Please find below a breakdown of payments which will support those of you who wish to split the cost over the next few months. Alternatively, if you prefer, you can make a one off payment of £152.00. All payments need to be made no later than Friday 27 April 2018. Payments should be made through ParentPay in the usual way, choosing the option Blackwell Court 2018. If you are experiencing any problems paying through ParentPay or need a bar coded letter, please contact the school office.

If you wish to divide the remaining cost of £152 over four months, we have put the following in place:

As stated on the first letter, parents are asked to collect their children from Blackwell after lunch on their final day (a specific time will be advised when the timetables are received, but it is likely to be around 1.00pm). In previous years parents have welcomed the opportunity of seeing the Manor House and being shown around the amazing facilities and grounds by their children. This also means we do not incur additional return journey costs thus keeping costs to a minimum. Please see the office if there is any difficulties with this arrangement.

We will be holding an information evening for parents; this will take place at **6.30pm on Wednesday 25 April**.

The children are already looking forward to this exciting visit and I know that they will have a thoroughly memorable time.
