NURSERY UPDATE



Nursery have enjoyed a week thinking about their feelings. We listened to different pieces of music and talked about how the music made us feel. We explored this further through expressive dance and art. It was wonderful to see all the different interpretations.

Next week we will be thinking about transition into Reception. We will be talking about our favourite memories of Nursery and what we are excited about doing in Reception. We will be looking through our Learning Journals and reflecting on the fantastic progress we have made. RECEPTION

This week in Maths we have been measuring length using non standard units such as hand span, foot steps and strides and have consolidated our learning of counting in twos. If your child is secure to 20, why not try to 50 or more or perhaps count backwards! In Literacy we have been using time related language such as first, next, after and finally to retell the story of 'The Hungry Caterpillar'. The children have also been introduced to the app 'Seesaw' and are becoming skilled at creating, recording and storing their own work. Here they are in action!
