



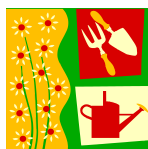

### **What is a School Nutrition Action Group (SNAG)?**

A School Nutrition Action Group is a school-based alliance in which teaching staff, pupils and caterers, supported, where appropriate, by health and education professionals and the local community, work together to review and improve the school food service and adopt a truly whole school approach to food education and culture.

A SNAG is an important part of the Food for Life Partnership Mark and goes beyond lunches, to include the quality of food at school. It will also include food growing, cooking activity and links being made to local farms and food producers so that pupils find out more about where food comes from.

**Typical membership of a SNAG includes:**

- A member of the Senior Management Team
- Member(s) of the teaching staff. This could be a cooking champion.
- Pupils
- Parents / Governor
- Catering supervisor or area manager
- School cook
- Midday supervisor
- Representatives from the community as appropriate



The school team are all ready and rearing to go, but now we desperately need parents to join our team. Our next meeting will be on the 24th of February 2014. A typical meeting will run termly for approximately 1 hour. If you cannot make this meeting but would still like to be involved please still return the interest slip below.
