Dear Parents

Re: Year 1 Visit to The Black Country Museum



To start off our topic on 'Back to the Future' in the Autumn Term, we have planned a visit to The Black Country Museum on Wednesday 13 September.

The children will need to wear school uniform as normal and will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and returning at approximately 3.00pm. If it is hot, please remember to put sun cream on your child beforehand and, if there is any possibility of rain, please include a waterproof coat. The children will require sensible shoes as there will be a considerable amount of walking.

Universal Free School Meals means that your child is entitled to a packed lunch provided by school. Children have the option of one sandwich filling (cheese, ham or tuna). Also included in the packed lunch are carrot/cucumber sticks, a piece of fruit and a slice of cake/shortbread. Parents are asked to provide two suitable drinks for the day, both in a disposable carton and in a named plastic carrier bag.

Alternatively, you may wish to send your child with a packed lunch on this day. We ask that this is provided in a named plastic carrier bag, with two suitable disposable drinks. For practical reasons, please do not send glass bottles, yoghurt pots, chocolate or any food containing nuts.

The cost for this trip is £13.00 per child. Please pay in the usual way through ParentPay, choosing 'Black Country Museum Trip' by Friday 1 September. Unfortunately, if insufficient funds are received, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please note, children will not require any money on the day.

When making your payment please indicate in the 'Notes' field, what sandwich filling your child would like, or whether they will be bringing their own packed lunch. **Please note** - all children to bring two disposable drinks from home.

Please contact the school office if you are experiencing any problems with making this payment on ParentPay, or if you need a bar code letter.

If you are able to help on the trip could you please see one of the Year 1 staff.

We look forward to an interesting and enjoyable visit.
